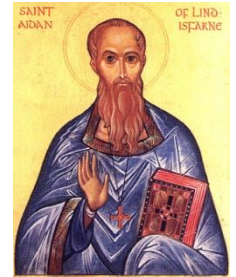
Little Church: All young children are invited to ‘Little Church’ for their own special prayers. Please come forward when called by the priest.
